Assumption of Risk, Waiver and Indemnification
MUST BE COMPLETED, SIGNED & INCLUDED WITH ENTRY

This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

I [PRINT NAME HERE] _____ (hereafter, "Undersigned", which term includes Participant's parent or legally-appointed Guardian, if a minor), freely and voluntarily seek to participate with myself and/or with my horse in any or all programs, events and/or activities sanctioned, produced, or sponsored by Inner Circle Farm, Ltd. that include classes, competitions, shows, training programs, events and/or clinics. These activities, programs, and events will hereafter be referred to as "the Event" and Inner Circle Farm, Ltd. together with Laura A. Parker (owner), it's sponsors, manager, property owners, officials, organizers and affiliates and their respective directors, officers, members, employees, agents, volunteers, representatives, and designated officials will collectively be referred to as "Event Sponsor."

1. Acknowledgment of Inherent Risks of Equine Activities/Assumption of Risks.

The Undersigned is fully aware and acknowledges that there are numerous inherent risks of equine activities, whether preparing for, entering, attending, participating in, or leaving the Event. The inherent risks include those dangers and conditions which are an integral part of equine activities, including, but not limited to: (a) the propensity of an equine or other animal to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm, or death to persons on or around them; (b) the unpredictability of the equine's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movements and unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals; (c) certain hazards such as surface or subsurface conditions; (d) collisions with other animals or objects; (e) the potential of a participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the Undersigned, participant, or others, such as failing to maintain control over the equine or not acting within his or her ability; (f) the breakage or failure of tack or other equipment. As lawful consideration for participation in any or all of the Events, and with full knowledge and appreciations of the inherent risks involved in any aspect of the Event, hereby releases the Event sponsors and or affiliates.

2. Waiver and Release of Liability.

To the fullest extent allowed under New York law the Undersigned agrees to freely and voluntarily waive any and all rights to sue and hereby releases the Event sponsors and or its affiliates from all liability, loss, claims, or actions for injury, death, expenses, or damage to person or property resulting from the inherent risks of the Event, or resulting from an action or inaction by the Event Sponsor. This waiver and release is effective even if the injury, death or damage to person or property is caused by, or contributed to by, actions or failure to act of the Event Sponsor and which actions or inactions constitute ordinary negligence or a violation of any applicable law pertaining to equine activity liabilities. Neither the Undersigned nor their representatives shall make any claim against, maintain an action against, or recover from the Event Sponsor or others acting on their behalf for injury, loss, damage or death of the Undersigned, to the Undersigned's horse, or to the Undersigned's personal property (regardless of ordinary negligence by the Event Sponsor). In the event that the Undersigned or their minor child receives first aid treatment or service, the Undersigned further releases Event Sponsors from any and all claims whatsoever on account of said first aid treatment or service rendered before, during or after participation in such Events and the Undersigned acknowledges that no claims as to the availability of such services have been made. The

Undersigned agrees that this release is binding upon the heirs, representatives, executors, agents or administrators of the Undersigned.

3. Indemnification

The Undersigned agrees to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Event Sponsors and to hold harmless with respect to claims for damages or injury to the Undersigned or to the Undersigned's horse, and for any and all damages which are sustained or suffered by the Undersigned's minor children, legal wards and/or by any third person(s) [“third persons” are people who are not parties to this Agreement, including, but not limited to, other people, visitors, participants, etc.], including any and all injuries or damages whatsoever the Undersigned may cause, directly or indirectly, while participating in the Event.

4. Protective Headgear

The Undersigned has read Rules about protective equipment, including USEF Articles 318 and 1713, and DR120.5. As well as the NEDA Helmet Policy effective February 2011. The Undersigned understands that they are required to wear an ASTM approved helmet at all times when mounted on a horse, while recognizing that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries. If the Undersigned is a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, the Undersigned consents to the child's participation and agrees to all of the above provisions and agrees to assume all of the obligations of this waiver on the child's behalf.

5. Acknowledgment of Release Terms and Conditions

In signing the foregoing waiver the Undersigned hereby acknowledges and represents that they have carefully read the foregoing waiver, understands it and signs it voluntarily and that the Undersigned is over 18 years of age and is of sound mind.
